Project Name: Adelaide Oval Redevelopment

Award Citation: A defining feature of the major redevelopment of Adelaide Oval is the sculpted white roofs rising above the Adelaide Parklands. Whilst the roof forms of the eastern stand draw closely on those to the west designed earlier by Hassell with Cox, the dramatic roof over the southern stand extends this formal gesture and is in itself worthy of recognition. The use of a steel diagrid shell with translucent membrane roof creates a dramatic form and light-filled volume. This close correlation between the structural requirements and spatial and experiential outcomes is considered exceptional and worthy of the 2015 Colorbond Award for Steel Architecture.
