Imagine receiving your copy of the 'Architecture 2009' photographic diary and seeing the image of Tadao Ando's Water Temple, or the cathedral-like space of an Australian woolshed that you captured with your camera, featured on the front cover or within the 52 featured photos that comprise the diary.

EmAGN, the newly formed Australian Institute of Architects Emerging Architects + Graduates Network, offers a unique and exciting opportunity to be featured in a diary that celebrates the built environment.

FACTION, the ACT based EmAGN group, with the support of Dulux, invites you to submit up to five of your best Architectural images to celebrate the diversity and beauty of the built environment. A wide variety of photos will be accepted, including images that explore building details, built landscapes, metropolis and village situations, famous Australian and International built works, as well as lyrical built moments that celebrate the colour, composition, richness and materiality of our built environment.

Entrants will be required to submit their images, including titles, on CD and post them to the ACT Chapter of the Australian Institute of Architects, for arrival by 31 July 2008.

The Prize

Competition winners will receive formal recognition in the 'Architecture 2009' photographic diary. The three winning entrants will also receive a cash prize, and the winning image will be featured on the cover of the inaugural 2009 Australian Institute of Architects Photographic Diary.

In addition, 53 images will be selected from the range of entries to be featured in the inaugural 'Architecture 2009' photographic diary. Image credits, adjacent to the printed image, will acknowledge the author and image title.

The Judging Criteria

An expert panel will assess images on the following criteria:

1. Originality
2. Expression
3. Aesthetics
4. Composition
5. Interpretation of subject matter

Entry Form

Eligibility and Conditions of Entry

1. Entry into the 2009 Photographic Diary Competition is open to all members of the Australian Institute of Architects.
2. The images submitted must have been exposed by and owned by the entrant. A maximum of five (5) images per entrant is permissible. File naming of images to be: Institute membership number and then image number from 1-5, eg. membership number:1, image number:2, etc.
3. All images are to be submitted in electronic format on CD. Format type is to be jpeg, 300dpi (resolution). Any entries that vary from this format will be deemed ineligible. All entries are to be submitted on CD to:

4. The image subject matter is to have an architectural theme and/or reference to the broader built environment. Photographic interpretation of the subject matter should be the focus of the entry, rather than the architecture.
5. Entrants grant permission to the Australian Institute of Architects to reproduce images for exhibitions, RAlA Publications, and for any promotional purposes. All reproductions will become the property of the Australian Institute of Architects.
6. All reasonable care will be taken to give the photographer attribution in Australian Institute of Architects communication. Entrants must state the exact wording of the attribution they require on the entry form. The RAlA reserves the right to publish all details of winning entrants in Australian Institute of Architects communications.
7. Fifty three (53) winning images will be selected for inclusion in the 'Architecture 2009' photographic diary. Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) images as follows:

First prize: \$500 and use of winning image on the front cover of the diary
Second prize: \$300
Third prize: \$200

The jury panel's decision is final on all matters relating to the competition. The selected images will become the property of the Australian Institute of Architects.

8. All entry forms are to be completed correctly and must be included with the entry. Incomplete entry forms, including failure to state the attribution, will not be accepted.
9. All entries must be received at the Australian Institute of Architects, ACT Chapter by 4pm, Thursday 31 July 2008. No late entries will be accepted. All entries will remain the property of the Australian Institute of Architects and will not be returned.
