TERMS + CONDITIONS

- 1 The light must be a pendant light and will be exhibited via suspension from a ceiling mesh structure.
- 2 The starter kit that includes bulb, batten holder and power cord must be used and cannot be modified in any way eg. no additional bulbs added, no changes to length of cord, no change to type of power supply, etc.
- 3 All submissions must be received no later than 31st March to ensure that they can be included in the exhibition space. Upon submission the entrant will be sent their free ticket to the SPARCHLE party on 7th April.
- 4 The lights will be exhibited at the SPARCHLE party at Jones Bay Wharf at Suite 107 Jones Bay Wharf, 26-32 Pirrama Road, Pyrmont commencing at 6.30pm. Entry is free for entrants however all other attendees will need to purchase a ticket from DARCH. Please see website. No tickets available at door.
- 5 The judges decisions are final. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. A prize for 'Peoples Choice Award' will be voted for on the presentation night.
- 6 Entrants will not be able to collect their lights until the day after the SPARCHLE party from which time they will be available at RAI A, Tusculum, 3 Manning Street, Potts Point. DARCH will arrange for the storage of items for a period of 7 days after the event during which time they will be available for collection. Please contact Douglas McCloskey to arrange a time. If collection is not arranged within 7 days of the closing date (or unless notified in writing) DARCH may dispose of the articles as they see fit. Submissions can only be returned at the entrant's expense and may be collected by a company or team representative with authority to sign an acknowledgement of collection.
- 7 Insurance of entries while on exhibition, storage or in transit remains the sole responsibility of the entrant.
- 8 Entrants indemnify DARCH, RAI A, the venue and sponsors against any claim, including those by the entrant or third parties, arising from the exhibition and publicising of the work submitted.
- 9 Submissions should carry the identifying tag enclosed in the entry kit, with name of entrant or owner and contact details.
- 10 On submission of an entry you declare that it is an original piece of work and that you have the right to submit the work as owner of the design.
- 11 SPARCHLE event organisers and sponsors reserve right to exclude any submission deemed inappropriate for exhibition.
