OUTLINE

Buildings and Bodies - we really aren't that different! The way we live, breathe, talk as humans can be connected to specific elements of a building's composition.

This workshop focuses on how architecture relates to the human body and the specific vocabulary architects use on a day to day basis.

An interactive experience involving exciting imagery of various building elements, architectural buzz words and human body parts. Students have the opportunity to mix and match, exposing them to common words used in the architectural language.
