Vaccination for workers on construction sites

Vaccination

Supporting access to vaccination for construction site employees:

- Construction site employees (CSE) can now access a priority vaccination booking at state clinics (via the phone line)
- Increased capacity in northwestern state vaccination clinics and 20,000 priority access Pfizer appointments available through the call centre
- Age appropriate vaccines will be administered for 'walk-ups' i.e. <60 years will receive Pfizer, 60+ years will receive AstraZeneca (AZ)
- 'Walk-up' vaccinations are available at selected state clinics
- Open access to AZ at MCEC each afternoon from 3pm commencing Monday 13th and continuing until 26th September
- CSE may also be able to access vaccination via their GP or pharmacy

Key messages

- Strong encouragement around everyone booking an appointment and getting vaccinated as soon as possible
- Eligibility for vaccinations has now been opened up to anyone 12 years and over
- COVID-19 Vaccination is free for everyone. You do not need insurance, a visa, or Medicare card to get it
- Those eligible CSE's are able to get priority Pfizer bookings at state clinics (via the phone line)
- Construction site means a work premises at which civil works, building or construction activities take place
- CSE who have been told to isolate or have COVID symptoms, must not attend a vaccination clinic or appointment

Where to access vaccination

- GP clinics, community pharmacy and Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations
- There are over 60 state vaccination centres where bookings can be made

'Walk-up' vaccinations are available at selected times at the following state clinics:

- Ford Campbellfield
- Wyndham
- Melton
- Heidelberg Repatriation Hospital

Open access to AZ available at MCEC daily from 3pm between 13th and 26th September



How to make a booking

General and Priority access appointments

- Online and by calling the Coronavirus Hotline 1800 675 398
- Priority Pfizer bookings are only available between Monday 13 and Sunday 19 September.
 These appointments are <u>only</u> available via the Coronavirus Hotline 1800 675 398

Walk-up vaccination (age appropriate vaccine)

- Available at four **specified** state vaccination **clinics only**
- Limited times only from Monday 13 to Sunday 26 September

Open access to AstraZeneca vaccine

- Available at Melbourne Exhibition and Convention Centre (MCEC) daily from 3pm
- Limited times only from Monday 13 to Sunday 26 September

- COVID-19 Vaccination is free for everyone. You do not need insurance, a visa, or Medicare card to get it. Please bring identification with you to your vaccination appointment.
- Age appropriate vaccine is defined as: <60 years Pfizer, 60+ years AstraZeneca
