About The Role

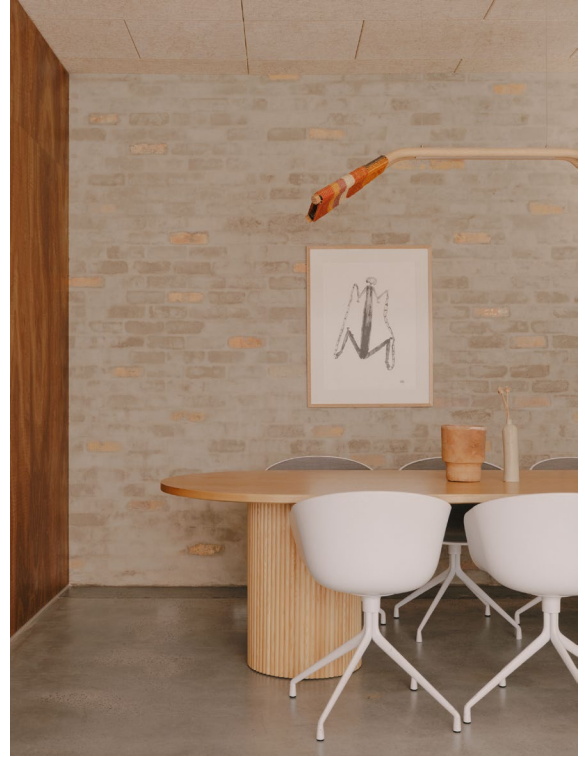
Our team is looking for a talented interior designer to become a key member of our team.
