This light will represent love, even when years have gone by.


This light will last forever, even as the memories may fade.


Slowly, as the lights are taken, the body of light will get smaller, until eventually the last light is then held.

At this point the official ceremony is over and people will take their light with them to remember lives lost and to know that they are not alone...




