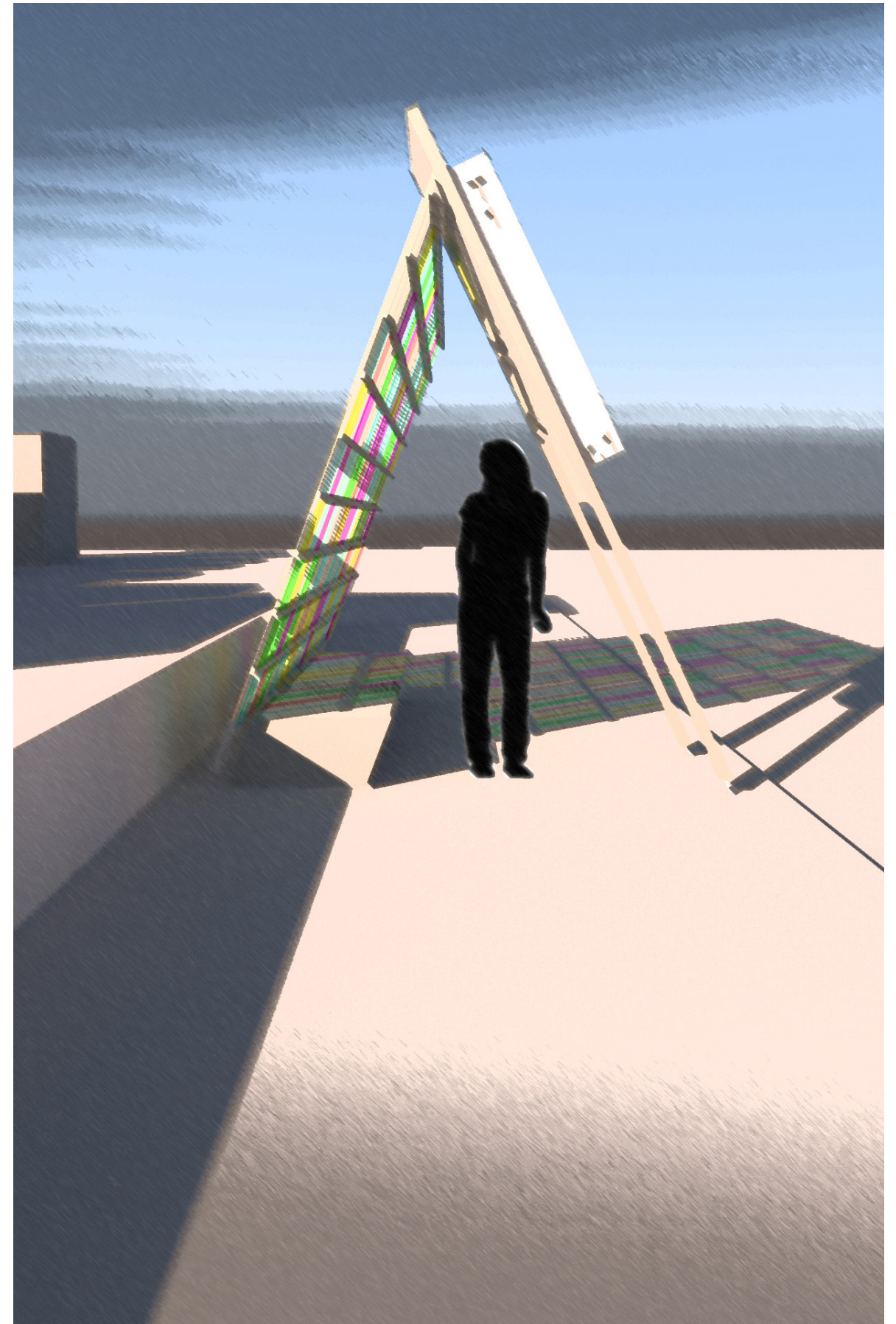
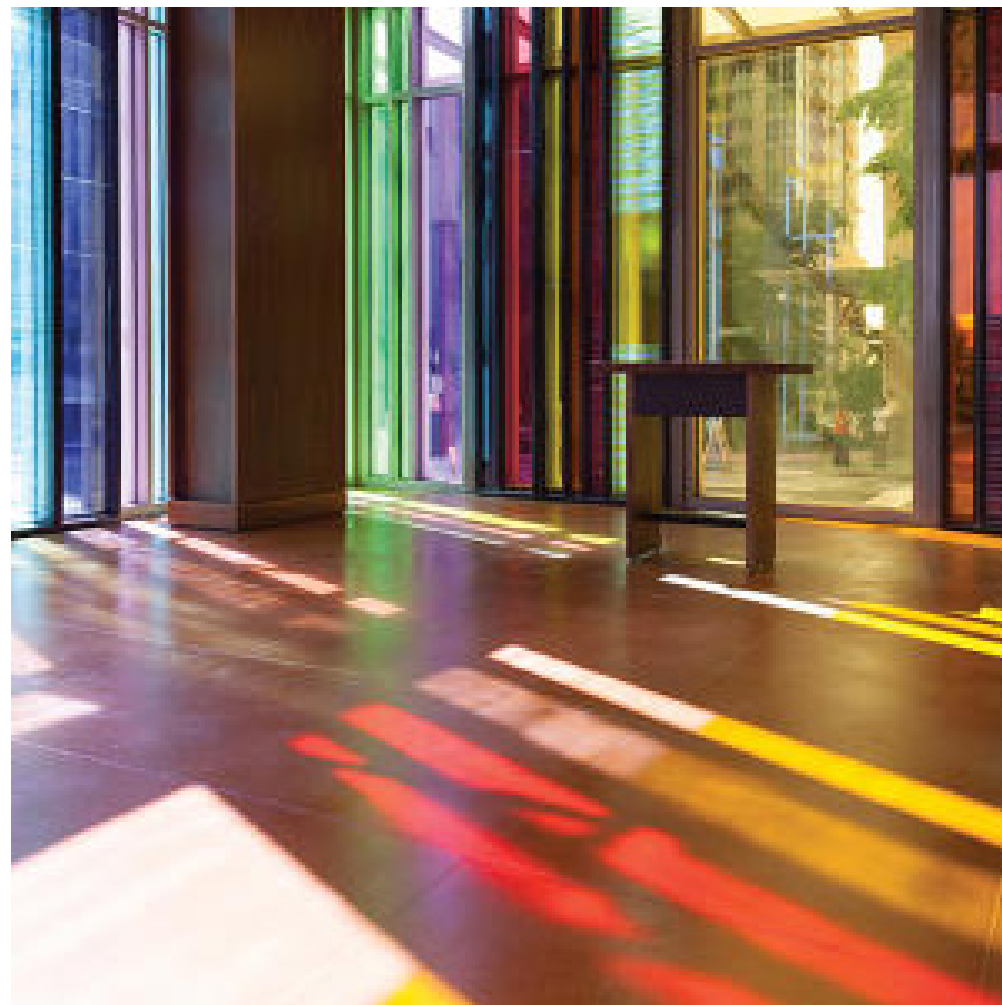
Paint Your Commute aims to introduce the colourful ambience to the daily commute in the form of a tram station waiting area. The creative approach incorporates the movement of the glass panel within the linear form. Thus, this allows the occupants to not only interact with the structure but also evokes the sense of ownership through their interaction. Indeed, as the panel are made from tinted recycled glass, its mobility through the clipping mechanism offers the commuter a chance to shuffle the panels or bring it home.



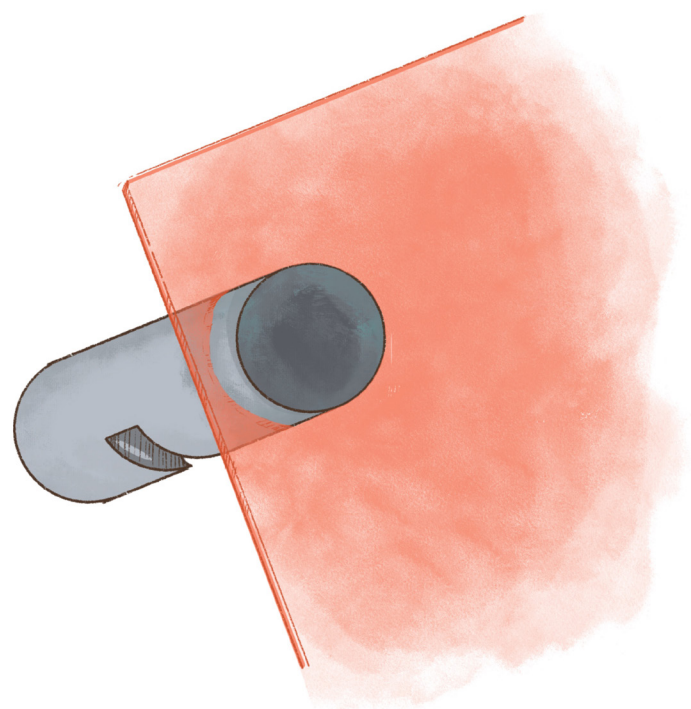
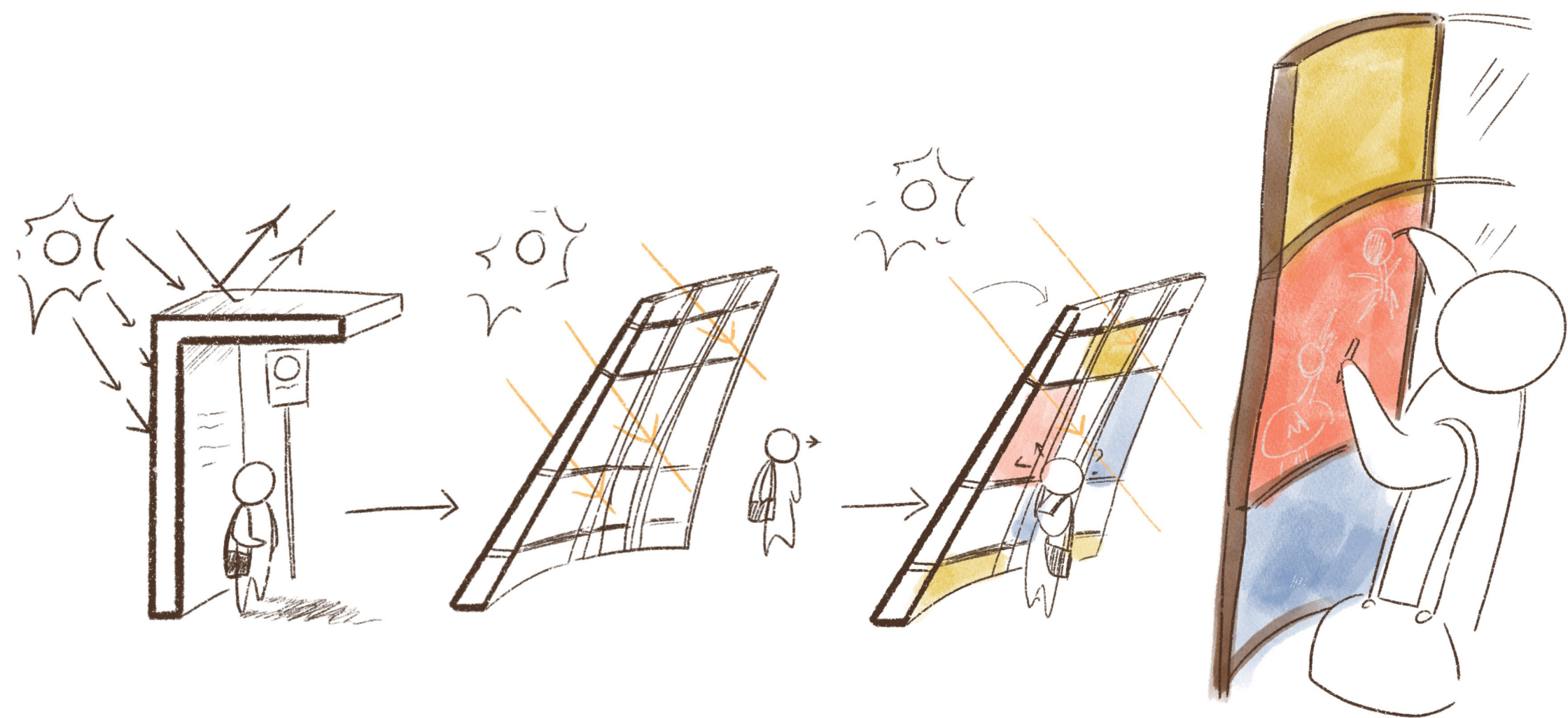
OLD GLASS



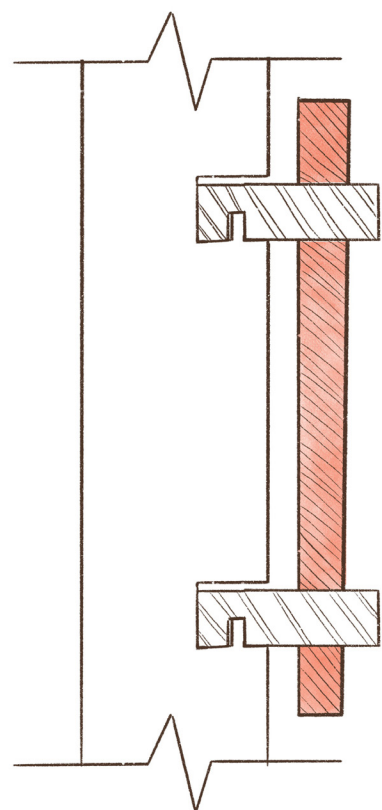
Use of old glasses from existing infrastructure like old train, bus or tram to be re-developed and tinted for the stained glass effect



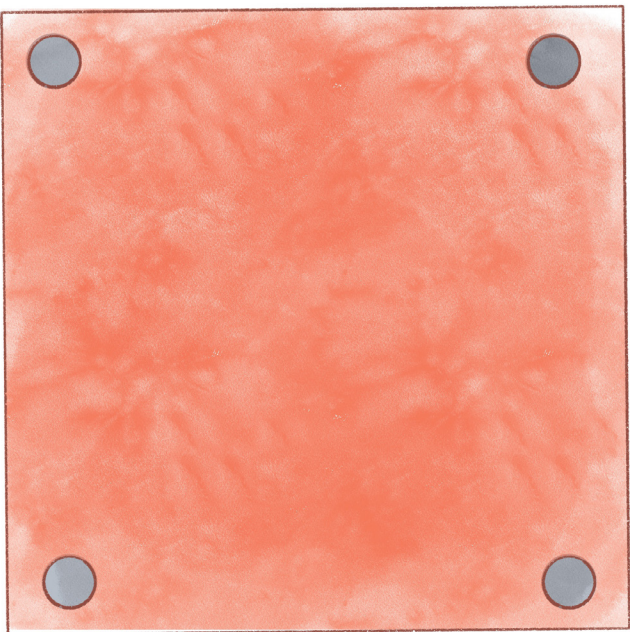

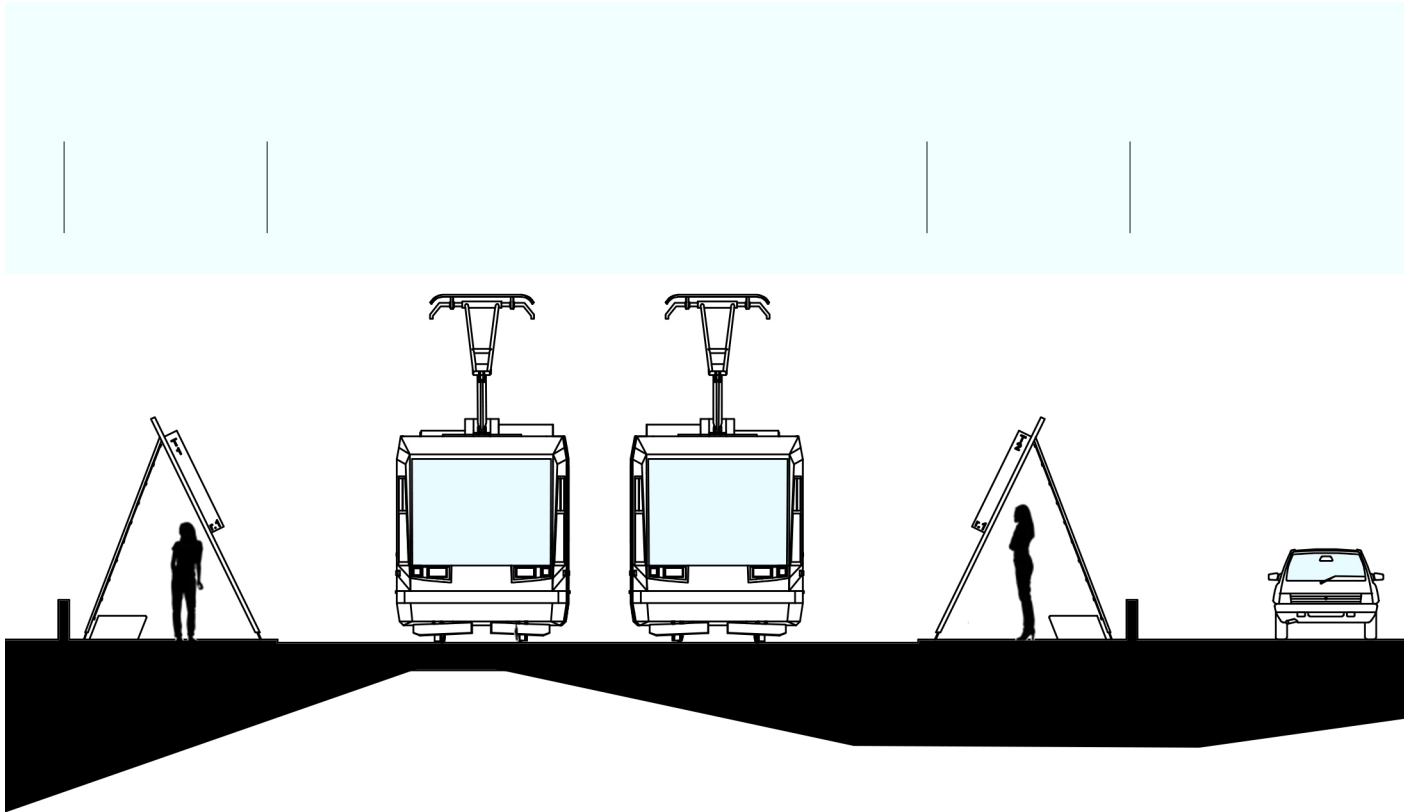


SECTIONAL DETAIL

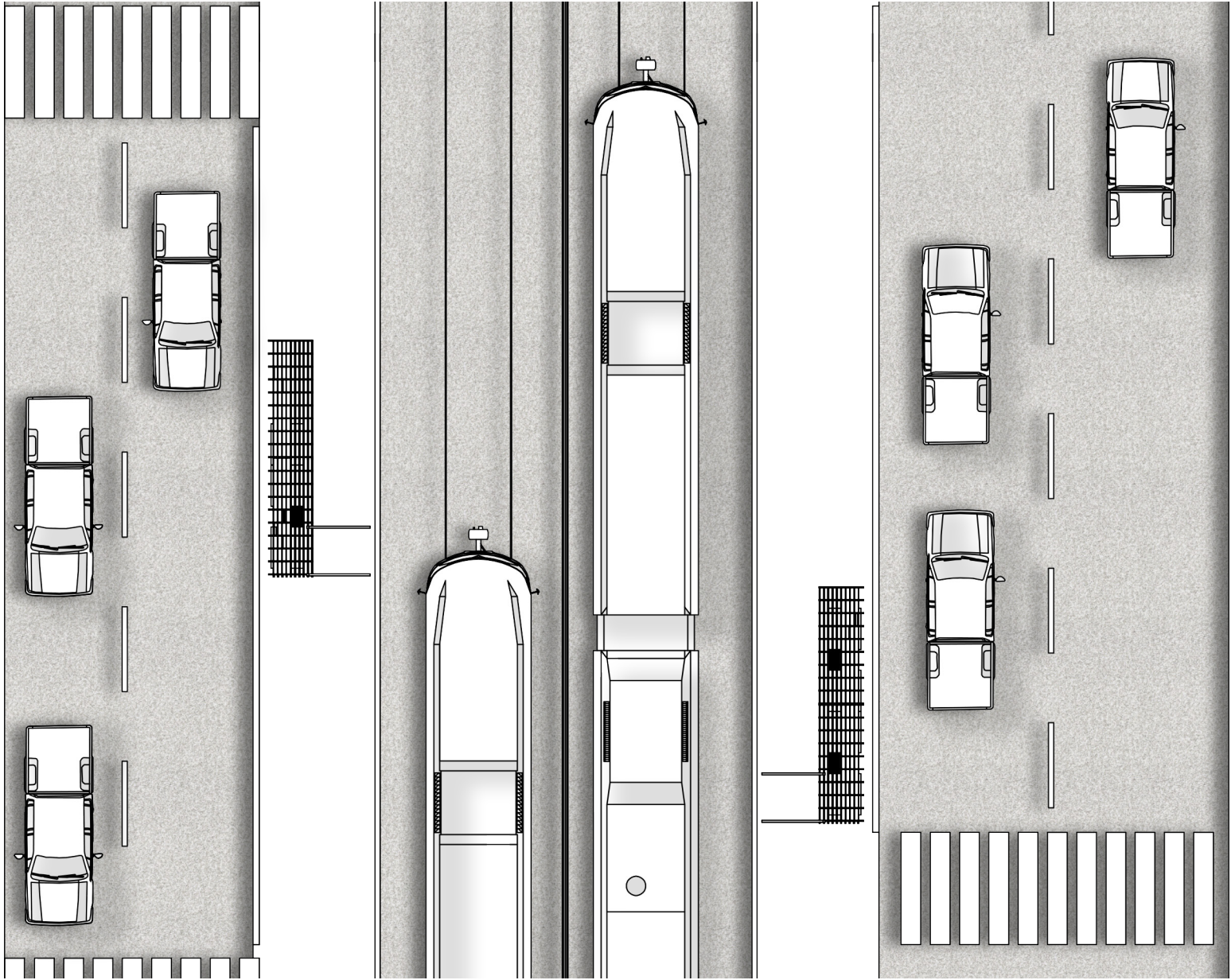


FRONT ELEVATION

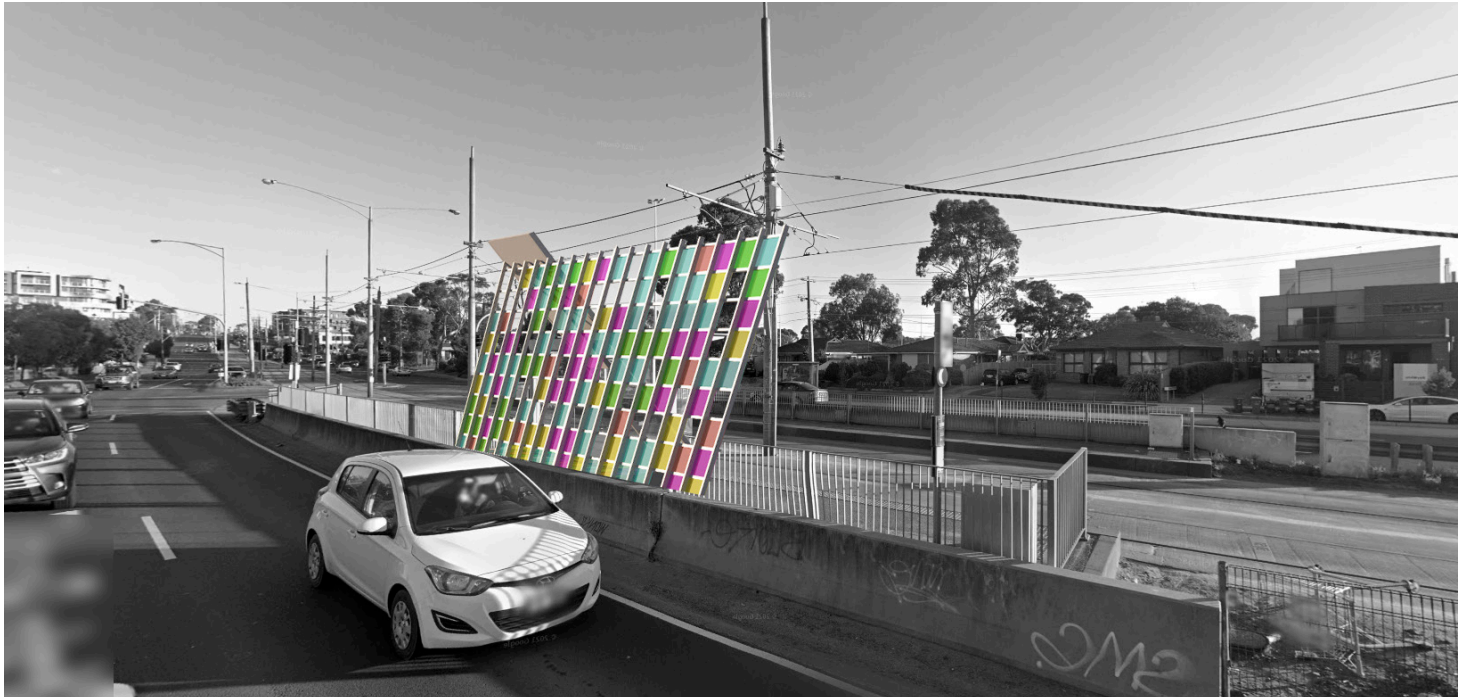
